

## **Radcliff Days Parade Rules and Safety Regulations**

1. Entries must be received at the Colvin Community Center, 230 Freedoms Way, Radcliff by Friday, September 6, 2019 at 5 p.m. to the contact person listed on the application.
2. The City of Radcliff reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
3. Parent drop-off will be in front of Stithton Baptist Church, 95 Park Ave, Radcliff. After collecting your group, proceed to the designated spot which will be in the back parking lot of Stithton (off the Walmart Way entrance).
4. Increased supervision of children leaving your group to hand out candy, making sure they return to your group. All persons riding on floats/vehicles of any type shall be in a safe position
5. All entries participate at their own risk.
6. Children under the age of ten (10) may not participate unless accompanied by an adult. An appropriate number of adults must accompany youth/youth groups. Participants are responsible for the actions and conduct of those who are a part of their entry- before, during and after the parade.
7. All animals must be kept on leads under complete control in their assigned spots and must be kept off private property at all times. Pooper scoopers are required with all animal entries.
8. All participants are expected to abide by the instructions of those in charge of staging and line-up.
9. In a community spirit, there will be no judging of entries in this parade nor will there be any review stand. This parade is strictly for community enjoyment.
