Applications are available at Radcliff City Hall, 411 West Lincoln Trail Blvd., Radcliff, Kentucky, 40160 between the hours of 8:30 am EST and 5:00 pm EST, Monday through Friday or may be downloaded from www.radcliff.org. Applications will be accepted through Wednesday, May 12, 2021 at 5:00 pm EST.

The following are the minimum requirements:

- High School Graduate or GED
- Firefighting experience preferred but not required
- Ability to successfully complete written, physical, and oral exams
- Free of Criminal History and successful background investigation
- Ability to successfully complete fire / rescue related courses as required
- Ability to obtain IFSAC Firefighter I & II Certifications within 1 year
- Ability to obtain EMT Emergency Medical Responder or EMT-B within 2 years
- Valid Kentucky Operators License or ability to obtain as prescribed
- Reached 18 years of age (or age 18 by hire date)
- Achieved issuance of the CPAT card by hire date
