Banner Application

The Mission is to honor and recognize the men and women who served, are currently serving, or have given their lives for our country in the United States Armed Forces. The objective is to honor our local veterans by obtaining customized banners to be displayed on poles along city streets until November 11, 2026. Please read the information below and complete the application form and obtain a banner for the veteran you'd like to honor.

1. Applications can be obtained online at www.radcliff.org or at Radcliff City Hall. They must be returned to Natalie at Signmakers (natalie@signmakershc.com) by September 4, 2026.
2. The cost of a banner is \$100 must be paid before the order will be placed.
3. The City will furnish materials to hang the banners at no expense to the sponsor.
4. Banners will be placed without reserved locations along W. Lincoln Trail Blvd and other streets as necessary.
5. The banners are durable and are expected to last for several years.
6. The City will make every effort to protect the banners but is not responsible for lost, damaged, or missing banners.
7. The banners will be displayed at the discretion of the City. The anticipated display period will be September through Veterans Day.
8. Banners will be returned to contact person after the display period.
9. No additional embellishment or decoration of the banners or power pole upon which they are mounted is permitted.
10. Only one banner may be displayed for any individual service member.
11. Service members must have served in the U.S. Army, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, Marine Corps, Space Force or National Guard.
12. If the rank of the servicemember is unknown, it may be left blank. Only the information provided in the application form will appear on the banner.
13. The sponsor must provide a good quality photo of reasonable resolution. The servicemember does not have to be in uniform in the photo.
14. You may submit a digital photo with this application form. If you only have a hard-copy photo, you may bring that to City Hall to have a digital image produced.
15. Payment may be made by check or money order (mail-in or in-person), or debit/credit card by calling 270-351-4714 by September 4, 2026. Checks are to be made payable to "City of Radcliff."
