Radcliff Days Parade Rules and Safety Regulations

1. Entries must be received at the Colvin Community Center, 230 Freedoms Way, Radcliff by Monday, September 14, 2026 at 5 p.m. to the contact person listed on the application.
2. The City of Radcliff reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
3. All entries participate at their own risk.
4. Traffic will not be allowed on State Street other than parade entries. You must have your float ready before entering the lineup. (This includes participants on the float, candy or other items on the float. You will not be permitted to drive on State St. to take items or people to a parade entry. Please make sure all of your participants are aware of this.)
5. Parent drop-off will be at the corner of Atcher and State St in Radcliff. After collecting your group, proceed to the designated spot (as directed by the line-up crewmember) on the right-hand side of State St. (Leave the left lane open for setup traffic.)
6. Increased supervision of children leaving your group to hand out items (candy/flyers/etc.) must be maintained in order to make sure they return to your group. All persons riding on floats/vehicles of any type shall be in a safe position
7. Children under the age of ten (10) may not participate unless accompanied by an adult. An appropriate number of adults must accompany youth/youth groups. Participants are responsible for the actions and conduct of those who are a part of their entry- before, during and after the parade.
8. All animals must be kept on leads under complete control in their assigned spots and must be kept off private property at all times. Pooper scoopers are required with all animal entries.
9. All participants are expected to abide by the instructions of those in charge of staging and line-up.
10. In a community spirit, there will be no judging of entries in this parade nor will there be any review stand. This parade is strictly for community enjoyment.
